

APPLY FOR AN ACWW "MODEL" PROJECT IN THE COUNTRY OF STUDY

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - No entry fee.

Apply for an ACWW "Model" project to help the local women and children in the Country of Study. Research an initiative that falls within the ACWW Projects Guidelines. Members need to complete an ACWW Project application form and provide an overview of how the project will work and how it can be implemented and maintained. <https://www.acww.org.uk/projects.html>

NOTE: This is NOT to actually finance a project in the Country of Study, this exercise is to encourage members to consider issues of the local women, think how we could make a difference and understand the process of applying for and gaining funding for an ACWW Project.

The ACWW Funding Guidelines form the rules of this Competition. Entry form (**I 1-15**) must be attached. Entries received without the **I 1-15 form** will be disqualified.

NOTE: ACWW does not fund projects in the more developed countries of the world including UK, USA, Canada, Australia, New Zealand and Western Europe. If the Country of Study falls into this category, then the Project will be intended for a neighbouring nation in the same ACWW Area.

Applications to be mailed in a clearly labelled envelope with entry form (**I 1-15**) to the State International Officer's home before **1 February** for judging.

DO NOT SUBMIT ENTRIES TO ACWW – this is purely a CWA of NSW "Model" Competition to give members an insight into the ACWW application process from a Country of Study woman's point of view.

First place (\$50), second place (\$30) and third place (\$20) winners will be announced during the State International meeting at State Conference.
